

Tomato Varieties:

Beefsteak:

Beefmaster – 80 days, 1-2lb. fruit size. Meaty red fruit, disease resistant. Indeterminate.

Big Beef – 73 days, 12 oz. Big, smooth shoulders and firm fruit. Indeterminate.

Delicious – 77 days, HUGE crack-free, solid fruit, up to 2lb. Indeterminate.

Bush:

Better Bush – 68 days, 8 oz. Compact vigorous plant, good for containers. Indeterminate.

Bush Goliath – 68 days, 10-12 oz. fruit with high sugar content. Determinate.

Patio – 70 days, 3-4 oz. compact tomato. Great for small space or pots! Determinate.

Sandwich/Slicers:

Better Boy – 70-75 days, 1lb. fruit. Vigorous vines and great resistance! Indeterminate.

Big Boy – 78 days, 10 oz. Vigorous plants. Yield until frost. Indeterminate.

Early Girl – 50 days, 6-8oz. Great early choice! Indeterminate.

Goliath – 65 days, 10-16 oz. Great all-around tomato with great yield! Determinate.

Park's Whopper's – 65 days, 14 oz. Great, big, producer! Indeterminate.

BHN 602 – 70-90 days, 10-12oz. firm tomato. Great resistance! Determinate.

Heirloom:

Arkansas Traveler – 80 days, 6-8oz. fruit. Pink Slicer with classic tart taste. Indeterminate.

Brandywine – 85 days, 14 oz. Beefsteak variety. Indeterminate.

Cherokee Purple – 75-90 days, 10-12 oz. Beautiful brown/red tomatoes. Indeterminate.

Chef's Choice Black – 75 days, 5-6in. Meaty & Full flavor! Indeterminate.

Homestead – 70-85 days, 7-8 oz. Dark red, meaty flesh. Determinate.

Mr. Stripey – 80 days, 1-2lb. Beefsteak, pretty and luscious! Indeterminate.

Mortgage Lifter – 80 days, 1-2lb. Immense, tasty fruit. Indeterminate.

Rutgers – 75 days, 7 oz. Old time flavor and great color. Determinate.

Canning/Sauce:

Celebrity – 67 days, 8 oz. Wonderful producer for canning. Determinate.

Roma – 75 days, 2 oz. elongated fruits. Great for sauce! Determinate.

Sausage – 70-75 days, 6in. long, meaty, full-body fruit! Heirloom, Indeterminate.

Salad:

4th of July – 45-50 days, 3 oz. plum sized tomatoes. Great snack size! Indeterminate.

Juliet – 60 days, 1 oz. elongated cherry tomato. Grows in clusters. Indeterminate.

Jelly Bean – 66 days, ½ oz. small round, cherry tomatoes. Red. Indeterminate.

SuperSweet 100 – 70 day, 1oz. Pendulum clusters, disease resistant, Indeterminate.

Tumbler – Only in baskets! 45 days, medium size, spreading, cherry tomato. Determinate.

Gourmet Artisan Cherry Mix – 75 days, beautifully striped, mixed colors. Indeterminate.

Yellow:

Lemon Boy – 60 days, medium sized bright yellow fruit. Firm and fleshy. Indeterminate.

Pepper Varieties:

Bell:

Socrates – 62 days, Early green bell, blocky. Turns to red with maturity.

Islamorada – 72 days, Elongated bell, green to red. Great disease resistance!

Yellow – 78 days, Nice, blocky bell. Green to yellow.

Orange – 65-70 days, very sweet and good disease resistance.

Chablis – 70 days, Ivory bell turns orange then red. Grows pointing UP!

Purple Beauty – 70 days, holds its sweet flavor.

Mini Belle Mix - 63-68 days. Mini, multi-colored sweet bell peppers. 1 1/4in. by 1 1/4in.

Salad:

Yummy – 55 days, 2-3” sweet orange pepper, eat them right off the plant!

Sweet Banana – 60 days. Great for salads or canning! 4” sweet fruit, green to yellow.

Pimento – 80 days, super sweet and meaty, all ready for your pimento cheese!

Corno di Toro Bullhorn – 75 days, Sweet ‘cowhorn’ pepper, 8-10in. long! Great roasted.

Candy Cane Chocolate – 40-45 days, sweet, striped pepper. Beautiful colors!

Long Tall Sally – 60-65 days, Italian frying pepper loaded with sweet flavor. 3-5in. long

Chili:

mild Pepperocini – 75 days, Sweet/tangy chili, great for pickling.

Anaheim – 80 days, 7” mild chili.

Serrano – 80 days, 3” hot chili pepper.

Tabasco – 80 days, Tabasco sauce hot! Vigorous and productive.

hot Cayenne – 75 days, 5-6” wrinkled fire hot chili!

Thai Hot – 85 days, 2” fruit. Beautiful colors, but hotter than Cayenne!

Chiltepin (Bird’s Eye) – 80-95 days, ¼ to ½ in. round, HOT fruit.

Hot:

mild San Ardo (Poblano) – 75 days, mild, 6in. long glossy fruit.

Jalapeño – 3” thick-walled, green to red pepper. HOT fruit!

Bularte Jalepeno – Jumbo!! Fruit up to 4in. long! Milder than regular Jalepeno.

Hot Banana – 75 days, 6” waxy yellow fruit maturing to red.

Jamaican Scotch Bonnet – 100 days, colorful, Caribbean pepper. Fruity, but hot!

Hot Habanero – 95 days, 1-2” pepper. 20 times hotter than Jalapeño! Green to yellow.

Ghost Pepper – 120+ days, one million Scoville Heat Units! 2-3 in. long.

Carolina Reaper – 90-100 days, Twice as hot as the Ghost Pepper, 1-2 in. long.
